- take responsibility for (one's actions)
 You need to learn to take responsibility for your own mistakes.
- take responsibility for (doing something wrong) I think that, if anyone, Amy should be the one to take responsibility for losing the account.
- take full responsibility Please forgive me. I take full responsibility.
